

Grand Blanc CEO delivers opening remarks at world's largest student investment conference in Dayton, Ohio

GRAND BLANC, MI – David Kudla, the CEO and chief investment strategist of Mainstay Capital Management in Grand Blanc, will deliver the opening remarks for the largest student investment conference in the world on Thursday, April 4.

Hosted annually at the University of Dayton in association with the United Nations Global Compact, RISE – Redefining Investment Strategy Education – brings together students and faculty from nearly 200 universities and other academic institutions for presentations and panel discussions.

RISE is also the longest-running student-run investment forum in the country. It brings together investment professionals with students and faculty in an interactive, informative setting.

Since it began in 2001, RISE has attracted nearly 15,000 participants from the financial industry, and colleges and universities from around the globe.
